## **General Notes:**

Sound and wardrobe began show preparations at 1:00, and PAs began to sweep and mop the stage at 1:07. Intimacy call began in the Mallett followed by dance lift call at 1:41. Fight call began in the Hansen at 1:45 and we looked at the hits with the manuscript in detail. At 1:57 PAs were in costume and finished on-stage preset. House opened at 2:05. We had a large audience tonight, and held for house until 2:33. The curtain speech this afternoon was given by Rich Dionne. In scene 1.12 when Will was climbing the balcony the center facing off the balcony fell off. It did not place the actors in immediate danger or cause harm to them. Virginia contacted house management and backstage to alert them that we were planning to call a 5 minute hold to repair the set. After actors had their feet on the ground Virginia called a hold and

	announced to the house that we were repairing the set and would continue the performance in 5 minutes. Deck carpenter Heather Mello made the repair with assistance from Clare Hilton. We continued the performance 6 minutes later from after Viola's exit and before the Nurse's scream, omitting the climbing action and asking the nurse to look over the balcony to spot Will and Marlowe. Beyond this, we had a pretty smooth run. Act I ended at 3:48, and Act II began at 3:58. During the 2.7 the wedding swag broke in two (see prop notes). Our run ended at 5:10. We had a wonderful and reactive audience who applauded between scenes (and for Heather's mid-show repair). I hope you all enjoy some well-deserved nights of rest before our next performance.

Props Notes:	<ul> <li>WEDDING SWAG. The wedding swag came apart about 2/3 of the way through its length when PAs were holding it towards the beginning of the wedding scene. They draped the loose length over the balcony and held their positions to the end of the scene.</li> </ul>		
Scenic Notes:	<ul> <li>BALCONY FACING. The CS facing of the balcony fell off in the middle of the run. It was repaired with screws during a hold.         <ul> <li>Thank you, Heather!!</li> </ul> </li> <li>FOAM ROOFS. The foam roofs (specifically SL) are becoming weaker and shake when the platform is walked on - they could use further reinforcement.</li> </ul>
